TEMPORARY EXHIBITS

October 6 – November 14, 2007 – *Art of the Sea* featuring G.C. Whiticar's paintings with a special section dedication to the beautiful "works of art" created by the craftsmen at Whiticar Boatworks over the past 60 years.

NEW PERMANENT EXHIBITS

Let's Play! – A display of vintage toys including model planes, trains and automobiles, as well as dolls, games and children's books from the late 1800s to the 1960s.
